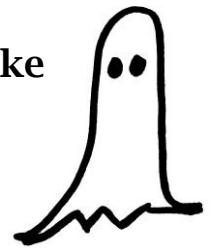
Saturday, October 20th, 2018 2:00 - 5:00 p.m.

SPCA's History and Mission

The SPCA was begun in 1941 to get electric streetlights installed and to make our alleys passable. Since then, the SPCA has been instrumental in getting trees planted on parkways, obtaining CTA bus service, constructing the pedestrian underpass at Lowell and Granville, installing traffic controls, and saving the ambulance that was going to be removed from our fire station at Peterson and Pulaski.

Currently, we co-sponsor the 4th of July picnic and Halloween party at Sauganash Park. We sponsor the Halloween Parade/Party and Summer Movie Night in our neighborhood; the Blue Light Initiative to support local law enforcement; and the House Decoration Contest each December. We provide mosquito control; organize the Earth Day neighborhood clean-up and tree-planting initiative; provide snow removal for our streets; deal with neighborhood issues; interact with the Police Department; and communicate with our elected officials to obtain improved community services.

The more members we have, the stronger our voice!

We also maintain a website and Facebook page, and we sponsor two meetings (Spring and Fall) each year with informative guest speakers and an opportunity for community dialog.

We are working hard to improve the quality of life for all of us in Sauganash Park and we appreciate your support.
